Note: The essay is given careful consideration by the selection committee. Please ensure your essay is given significant attention in your application. It need not be longer than 2-pages.

Two (2) Letters of recommendation [10 Points]

- Please ensure those providing a reference letter include their name, phone number, length of time they have known you, and reasons why they believe you are deserving of a scholarship.

A copy of your Grades or Transcript for the last academic school year.

Acceptance letter from a university or college if this will be your first year.

A head and shoulders photo, of high enough quality to be used in digital and print publications – JPG format.

It is the applicant's responsibility to contact Curling Canada to verify that all required forms are on file by the deadline date.
