Getting to Langley, BC

For those arriving by air, Vancouver International Airport is your gateway to BC. Langley is located approximately 1 hr 15 minutes from the Vancouver airport via Hwy 99 or 91 and Hwy 10. Another nearby airport is the Abbotsford International Airport – approximately 30 minutes from Langley via Hwy 1 or the Fraser Hwy. Ground transportation to Langley is by vehicle. Available options to get to Langley are by renting a car at the airport.

Langley Curling Centre and the George Preston Recreation Centre (side by side within the same building) – 20699 42 Ave, Langley, BC, V3A3B1

The **Opening Ceremony** will be held Saturday, January 18 at 6:30 pm at the George Preston Recreation Centre.

The Draw Schedule can be viewed online at <http://www.curling.ca/2020juniors/schedule/>. Athletes will be arriving January 16, practicing on January 17 with Draws beginning January 18 and running through until January 26.

Draw times are 9:00 am, 2:00 pm & 7:00 pm daily until playoffs, with the exception of Saturday, January 18, where the draw will be at 7:30.

- Men January 25 at 4:00 pm
- Championship - Women January 26 at 9:00 am
- Men January 26 at 2:00 pm

Both the Semi Finals and Championship Finals will be televised live on TSN.

Seating will be first come first served in both venues. Langley Curling Centre – on ice bleachers on sheet 6. Games will be played on sheets 3-5. There will be limited seating inside the curling centre.

George Preston Arena – the seats are plastic bucket seats with ample seating on the long ends. There will be no seating on the end sheets.

Horse & Rider Restaurant and Bar

The Horse & Rider Restaurant and the Bar at the George Preston Recreation Centre are located on the upper level of the Langley Curling Centre. The bar is licensed for all ages, kids are welcome, but must be accompanied by an adult. There is a concession on the arena side.

Coffee, hot chocolate, muffins, etc will be available daily for breakfast in the concessions on both sides starting at 8 am. Buffet lunch and dinner will also be available daily at the Horse & Rider Restaurant. There will be healthy 'Subway style' sandwiches available for purchase. The Horse & Rider will be offering an eat 10 meals coupon, get the 11th free.

We have a pool table, cool curling, dart boards and a TV to keep you entertained during your down time.
