Getting to Langley, BC

For those arriving by air, Vancouver International Airport is your gateway to BC. Langley is located approximately 1 hr 15 minutes from the Vancouver airport via Hwy 99 or 91 and Hwy 10. Ground transportation to Langley is by vehicle. The host committee has provided a \$500 stipend to each team to help with ground transportation during the event, which will be paid out once receipts are received by Curling Canada. **Busses will NOT be provided at this year's event, each team is responsible for their own transportation.**

Players & Coaches Accommodation:

Curling Canada has booked the entire Sandman Hotel Langley – 8855 202 Street, Langley for players and coaches only.

Player's (only) Lounge – located in the Sandman Hotel will be open (7:00 am – noon) and then again from (7 pm – midnight) for players **only**; light snacks will be provided. Each room will be provided with a case of water.

Langley Curling Centre and the George Preston Recreation Centre (side by side within the same building) – 20699 42 Ave, Langley, BC, V3A3B1

The Langley Curling Centre has a well stocked pro-shop. Should you require any equipment, supplies, pants, etc during the event, visit the Langley Curling Centre Pro-shop!

Lockers:

The Langley Curling Centre will be providing 2 lockers per team to securely store your gear. Please bring 2 locks to secure your lockers. Lockers will be allocated on a first come first served basis.

Team Gear and Provincial Team Uniforms:

As in years past, we understand that many teams will have gear and uniforms shipped directly to BC. We ask that you have your supplier ship the gear to the Langley Curling Centre, 20699 42 Ave, Langley, BC, V3A3B1 – Attention: YOUR TEAM NAME/PROVINCE.

Should the gear arrive prior to your arrival (prior to January 16), we will make arrangements to bring the items to the Sandman Hotel for your pick-up at the Welcome Desk. Any gear arriving after January 16 will be available at the Langley Curling Centre.

If you are having your gear shipped directly to BC, please have your supplier email Anita Tardi at anitatardi@shaw.ca with a tracking number and estimated date of arrival. We thank-you for your cooperation.

Future Stars:

We are excited to provide the opportunity for our Future Stars of Curling to meet YOU; the current Junior Stars of curling. Below is information regarding the 2020 New Holland Canadian Junior Future Stars at this year's Canadian Juniors.

- Future Stars will arrive 90 minutes prior to the draw. Allocated draw times are Saturday 9 am and 2 pm, Sunday 9 am, 2 pm, 7 pm, Monday 7 pm, Tuesday 7 pm. Prior to your arrival at the 2020 New Holland Canadian Juniors, a document containing Future Star Information including a short bio as provided by their parents, their designated junior team, and when they will be joining your team will be provided.
- Future Stars will be given a tour of the venue, presented their goodies, and will **meet their junior team approximately 60 minutes prior to the draw at the doors where the competitors are entering the George Preston Arena.**

- The Future Stars and their team will engage in a meet and greet and an official picture together.
- The Future Stars will shadow the team until the start of the game. If any team is not comfortable being shadowed, please speak to the adult representative with the Future Stars and accommodations will be made.
 - The Future Stars could participate in warm-ups.
 - The Future Stars will be on ice level for practice (but will not be on the ice during practice).
 - The Future Stars will lead the team into the arena for the draw.
 - The Future Stars will present the team with their commemorative gift from the host committee prior to the draw.
- The Future Star will return to the stands, to watch and cheer on their team for the draw.
