- Alberta (#1 seed) will play Lakehead in one semifinal Lakehead was tied with UNB and St. Francis Xavier at 3-4 for the final playoff position. In games amongst the three teams, their records were identical at 1-1. The tie-breaking solution in this case is the cumulative Last Stone Draw Distance for the round robin, where Lakehead was ranked #1, UNB was #3 and StFX was #4. Therefore Lakehead is ranked #4 overall.
- Alberta has hammer and choice of colour against Lakehead on Sheet C, Wednesday at 9 a.m. ET.
- Dalhousie finished tied with Laurentian at 4-3 but earned the second seed by virtue of their round-robin win over Laurentian. Dalhousie has choice of hammer **or** colour on Sheet D, Wednesday at 9 a.m.

Memorial (#1 seed) will play Regina in one semifinal. Fourth place was decided by games amongst the four teams tied at 3-4. Regina and Queen's' records were 2-1 while Wilfrid Laurier and Dalhousie were 1-2. Regina defeated Queen's in the round robin to earn the #4 seed, while Queen's is seeded #5. Wilfrid Laurier defeated Dalhousie in the round robin, ranking them sixth and Dalhousie 7th.

Memorial has hammer and choice colour on Sheet E against Regina, Wednesday at 9 a.m. ET.

Alberta and UPEI tied for second at 4-3; however Alberta defeated UPEI in the round robin, earning the #2 seed while UPEI is seeded third. Alberta has choice of hammer **or** colour on Sheet F, Wednesday at 9 a m
