

# Canad Inns Mixed Doubles Curling Trials: January 3 – 9, 2022

## Stride Place, Portage la Prairie, MB



### Qualification

#### **16 Teams – Round Robin play with 2 (two) pools of 8 (eight)**

##### **Playoffs:**

6 (six) Qualifiers – The 1<sup>st</sup> place finishers within each pool and the next best 4 (four) win/loss records qualify for a modified double-knockout playoff. The A-side winner plays B-side winner in the final. (Meaning you are allowed one loss after you qualify up until the Championship game)

##### **Teams:**

- 2 – 2020 and 2021 Canadian Mixed Doubles Champions
- 2 – Regional Bonspiel Qualifier Champions (events will be played in the 2020/2021 season)
- 2 – Top 2 teams from the CMDR as at May 1, 2020 (points from May 1, 2019 – April 30, 2020)
- 8 – Top 8 teams from the CMDR as at November 1, 2021 (points from May 1, 2020 – Oct 31, 2021)
- 2 – Top 2 teams from the CMDR as at November 1, 2021 (excluding CTRS, from May 1, 2020 – Oct 31, 2021)

### Eligibility

To be eligible for a CMDR entry, **each player** must compete in a minimum of four (4) CMDR events from June 1, 2019, to October 31, 2021

### FYI

- Members of the four-player men's and women's curling team representatives for the 2022 Olympics will not be eligible to participate in the 2022 Mixed Doubles Curling Trials.
- If both players from a Mixed Doubles Trials-eligible team are competing at the 2022 Olympics, that team will be replaced by the first team on the waiting list.
- If your Mixed Doubles team has an individual player competing at the 2022 Olympics, you will have an opportunity to replace that player.
- The replacement player must have been playing on a Men's or Women's team ranked in the top 12 of the Canadian Team Ranking System following the 2020-21 season, or on a Mixed Doubles Team ranked in the top 25 as at November 1, 2021.
- The replacement player must have played in a minimum of 2 mixed doubles events over the past season. (May 1, 2020 – Oct. 31, 2021)
- **Deadline to re-submit your new team line up is December 13, 2021**

There will be two (2) teams placed on a waiting list based on the CMDR as at November 1, 2021.

The waiting list teams will advise Curling Canada by November 3, 2021, if they wish to be placed on the waiting list knowing that the possibility to participate in the Mixed Doubles Curling Trials will not be known until December 14, 2021.
