



CMDR (Canadian Mixed Doubles Ranking) 2021 – 2022

Revised July - 2021

CMDR team points will be accumulated as below for the 2021/2022 season:

- After having been suspended for the full 2020-2021 season, CMDR points will once again start being awarded on August 12, 2021.
- The 2021/22 CMDR for Olympic Trials Qualification includes a team's best seven (7) results from mixed doubles events and/or a maximum of 3 CTRS results from March 15, 2019, to December 14, 2021. There are no carry over points from the 2018/2019 season.
- CMDR points will continue to be earned on an individual basis, meaning you still do not need to be playing with your teammate to earn CMDR points in a MD event.
- There is no minimum MD event requirement for a team to be included on the CMDR at the start of the 2021-22 season. Each individual is still required to play in a minimum of 2 MD events over the qualifying period to be considered eligible for a CMDR Olympic Trials Berth, including a minimum of 1 event together with your teammate prior to November 29, 2021.
- Players can earn CTRS points towards their Canadian Mixed Doubles Rankings. An individual's CTRS points earned are 25% of the teams total CTRS points earned in the event.
- As of July 20, 2021, there has been no official announcement on the resumption of the World Curling Team Rankings (WCTR) or the Canadian Team Ranking System (CTRS). If the WCTR/CTRS has not resumed by the time 4-person events start being played in Fall 2021, Curling Canada will award points to 4-person events for the express purpose of Mixed Doubles qualification to ensure fairness and consistency across the entire qualifying period. Each 4-person event will be assigned point values prior to the event being played and each individual participating in the 4-person event will receive 25% of the points earned by their 4-person team.

Team eligibility to qualify by CMDR points for the 2022 Canadian Mixed Doubles Championships:

- The qualifying process for the 2022 Canadian Mixed Doubles Curling Championship will be announced at a future date.

- WCF World Team Ranking Events
- ISS World Mixed Doubles Curling Tour Events
- Provincial or Territorial Playdowns
- Canadian Mixed Doubles Championship

In order for 2020/21 Tiered events to count towards CMDR points, the event must be registered with the WCF World Team Rankings OR the ISS World Mixed Doubles Curling Tour prior to December 15th, 2021 and not less than 30 days prior to the start of the event.

In events where a pay-per-win format is utilized, a maximum of 30% of the event purse may be allocated to the pay-per-win proceeds of the event. At least 70% of the event purse must be paid to the event qualifiers.

Tier 1 – Curling Canada Sanctioned Mixed Doubles Events

- Aly Jenkins Mixed Doubles Memorial, Qualico Communities Mixed Doubles Classic, Brantford Mixed Doubles Classic, Others TBD
 - 1st – 46 points
 - 2nd – 38 points
 - 3rd & 4th – 32 points
 - 5th – 8th – 26 points
 - 9th – 13th – 20 points
 - Non qualifying teams – 3 points per win

Tier 2 – WCF World Team Rankings / ISS World Mixed Doubles Curling Tour Events

- Event entry fee must be greater than or equal to \$400. Minimum 16 team field.
 - 1st – 32 points
 - 2nd – 26 points
 - 3rd & 4th – 20 points
 - 5th – 8th – 16 points
 - Non qualifying teams – 2 points per win

Tier 3 - WCF World Team Rankings / ISS World Mixed Doubles Curling Tour Events

- Event entry fee must be greater than or equal to \$250. Minimum 16 team field.
 - 1st – 24 points
 - 2nd – 20 points
 - 3rd & 4th – 16 points
 - 5th – 8th – 12 points

Tier 4 - WCF World Team Rankings / ISS World Mixed Doubles Curling Tour Events

- Event entry fee must be greater than or equal to \$100. Minimum 16 team field.
 - 1st – 18 points
 - 2nd – 14 points
 - 3rd & 4th – 11 points
 - 5th – 8th – 8 points

Other - WCF World Team Rankings / ISS World Mixed Doubles Curling Tour Events

- Event entry fee must be greater than or equal to \$200. Less than a 16-team field.
 - 1st – 20 points
 - 2nd – 16 points
 - 3rd & 4th – 12 points
 - 5th & 6th – 10 points

Provincial/Territorial Championships

- Minimum 12 team's entered to compete for a Championship, which includes regional/zone competitions.
 - 1st – 30 points
 - 2nd – 24 points
 - 3rd – page playoff – 20 points
 - 4th – page playoff – 16 points (3rd & 4th – 18 points)
 - 5th – 8th – 14 points

Provincial/Territorial Championships

- Less than 12 team's entered to compete for a Championship.
 - 1st – 16 points
 - 2nd – 12 points
 - 3rd – page playoff – 8 points
 - 4th – page playoff – 6 points (3rd & 4th – 7 points)
 - 5th – 8th – 4 points

Canadian Mixed Doubles Championship

- 1st – 50 points
- 2nd – 40 points
- 3rd & 4th – 32 points
- 5th – 8th – 24 points
- 9th – 12th – 18 points
- Round robin wins – 3 points

World Mixed Doubles Championship

- 1st – 40 points
- 2nd – 32 points
- 3rd – 28 points
- 4th – 24 points
- 5th – 8th – 20 points
- Round robin wins – 3 points
