CURLING CANADA

Under-25 NextGen Classic Information Mixed Doubles Event



This will be an annual event hosted by Curling Canada and held in early September at the **Saville Community Sports Centre in Edmonton, Alberta.**

The Mixed Doubles event will take place from **September 3 to 5, 2022**. This will be preceded by Men's and Women's events from August 31 to September 3, 2022 (see separate document).

The Mixed Doubles field will consist of 20 teams. The format will be four round robin pools, with eight teams then advancing to a single-elimination playoff.

Each team will be guaranteed five games. This includes four games against teams within their pool, plus one crossover game against a team from the other pool.

The purse breakdown for the Mixed Doubles event is as follows:

• Champions: \$3,000 (plus additional benefits listed below)

Runners-Up: \$2,000
Semi-Finalists: \$1,250
Quarter-Finalists: \$750

• Pay by Win: \$100 (non-playoff teams only)

The Champions automatically earn a berth in **Curling Canada's NextGen Future Program** for 2022-2023. To this end, their share of the purse will come in the form of NextGen Future funding.

With their inclusion in the NextGen Future Program, this team will also gain access to Curling Canada's National Coaches, among other benefits.

In order to compete in the Under 25 NextGen Classic, teams must have a **combined age less than 50** years as of June 30, 2022. This means that one player can be 25 or older.

These teams must also commit to competing in at least 2 tour events, plus their mixed doubles provincials, during the 2022-2023 season.

The Mixed Doubles for the Under 25 NextGen Classic will include:

16 teams from the 2021-2022 Canadian Mixed Doubles Rankings (CMDR), understanding that individual points can be combined for new teams.

Four teams selected by an internal Curling Canada panel. This recognizes that the COVID-19 pandemic could have differentially impacted the ability to earn points in 2021-2022.

Age-eligible teams will be required to submit your Application Form to helen.radford@curling.ca before 11:59PM EDT on June 30th, 2022

All included teams will be notified before July 5th, 2022. The **event entry fee of \$500** will be due to Curling Canada before July 20th, 2022. Please note that any team that has not paid its entry fee by the July 20th deadline will be replaced with the next team on the wait list.
