



Curling Canada National Team Program Funding Criteria for the 2024/2025 Season

Funding partners have designated that all National Team Program funding go towards the pursuit and likelihood of Podium Performances at World and Olympic Competitions.

All Curling Canada National Team Program Funding must align with the National Team Program Framework under the supervision of the High-Performance Director and the National Program Managers.

Able Bodied Program:

National Team Program funds will be distributed to five teams per gender, based on the possible scenarios listed below. (Total funds to distribute will be determined by June 15, 2024)

Scenario 1			
NTP Funds for 5 teams based on the CTRS as at April 15, 2024.			
Both the 2023 and 2024 Brier/Scotties Champions must be ranked within the top four on the CTRS.

3	Tier 2	20%	Next highest ranked CTRS team. Team will be in the 2025 Canadian Championship.

5	Tier 3	12%	Next highest ranked CTRS team. (Note - this team will have no AAP funds)

3	Tier 2	20%	Next highest ranked CTRS team. Team will be in the 2025 Canadian Championship.

Mixed Doubles National Team Program:

National Team Program funds will be distributed to a minimum of 7 Mixed Doubles teams (14 athletes) for the 2024-25 season.

Teams who will be funded are:

- 1) 2023 and 2024 CMDCC Champions.
- 2) All SR Mixed Doubles carded teams (includes athletes who would have been carded in MD if they had not received a higher value 4-person card).
- 3) All 2025 MD Trials qualified teams, even if not carded.

If there are any remaining NTP slots available to fill the 7 team/14 athlete quota, they will be awarded to the next-highest ranked team on the 2023-24 CMDR as of May 1, 2024.

Each athlete in the MD NTP will receive an equal amount of NTP funding to allocate towards competition, training & sport science. (Total funds to distribute will be determined by June 15, 2024)
