Note: These letters offer our selection committee an opportunity to learn another perspective of you and your contributions to part of the community, please select your references carefully.

A copy of your **Grades or Transcript** for the last academic school year.

Acceptance letter from a university or college if this will be your first year.

A head and shoulders photo, of high enough quality to be used in digital and print publications – JPG format.
